JUDGMENT

- 1. The claim was presented in the London south Employment Tribunal on 1 July 2024. The respondent has failed to present a valid response on time. The Employment Judge has decided that a determination can properly be made of the claim, or part of it, in accordance with rule 22 of the Rules of Procedure.
- 2. The respondent has made unauthorised deductions from the claimant's wages and must pay the claimant £6,596.88 gross.
- 3. The respondent failed to pay the claimant expenses incurred during the course of his employment and must pay him £279.69.
- 4. The claimant was dismissed in breach of contract in respect of notice and the respondent must pay damages to the claimant of £641.87.
- 5. The respondent must pay the claimant £7,518.44 in total.
- 6. It is for the claimant to account to HMRC for any sums it owes in respect of any sums received from the respondent pursuant to this judgement.
