JUDGMENT

The claim is struck out.

REASONS

1. By a letter dated 15 April 2025 the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to make representations or to request a hearing, as to why the claim should not be struck out because
 - the claimant had not complied with the Order of the Tribunal dated 18 December 2024.
 - it is no longer possible to have a fair hearing of the claim, because you have failed to identify the correct identity of your employer.
2. The claimant has failed to make representations in writing, or has failed to make any sufficient representations, why this should not be done or to request a hearing. The claim is therefore struck out.
3. The hearing fixed for 26-28 May 2026 will not take place.
