## **RE: Request for Information – RFI5107**

Thank you for your request for information which was processed in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

You requested the following information:

**I would like to know how much money Homes England paid to Nottingham City Council to purchase the Broad Marsh site in Nottingham. I would like this to cover all money given to the authority under the deal announced at the end of March 2025.**

## **Response**

We can confirm that we do hold the requested information. Homes England are paying Nottingham City Council £8,400,000+VAT in total for the freehold purchase of land at Broad Marsh Nottingham.

£7,900,000 was paid on 31 March 2025 on completion of the transfer of the 1<sup>st</sup> tranche, being the majority of the site area. A further £500,000+VAT will be paid for the 2<sup>nd</sup> smaller area once that part of the site is vacant.
