JUDGMENT

The unanimous judgment of the Tribunal is:

- 1. The Claimant's claims that she was subjected to detriments in the period 12 January 2023 1 February 2023, on the ground that she made protected disclosures were presented out of time in circumstances when it was reasonably practicable for her to have presented them in time; the Tribunal does not have jurisdiction to consider these claims; in the alternative the Tribunal found as at paragraph 2 below in any event.
- 2. The Respondents did not subject the Claimant to detriments, as alleged, on the ground that she made two protected disclosures on 12 January 2023.
- 3. The second Respondent dismissed the Claimant on 10 May 2023; the reason, (or the principal reason) was not that the Claimant had made protected disclosures.
- 4. All claims fail and are dismissed.
