Number of staff within your organisation who were formally disciplined for misconduct over the last three years (broken down by calendar year).

I'd also like to know the outcomes of the disciplinary action e.g.

- 14 staff dismissed
- 12 staff issued a written warning
- 16 staff given a final written warning
