IV. Health Information

I, the undersigned Official Veterinarian, certify that the birds described above meet the following requirements:

- a) Within 10 days prior to intended arrival into Bermuda, I examined the birds for export and found them to be free of any clinical sign of infectious, contagious or communicable disease and, to the best of my knowledge, each animal has not been exposed to any such disease that would endanger this animal, other animals or public health;
- b) The premises of origin is not infected with any communicable diseases;
- c) The birds for export are free from psittacosis as determined by one of the following:
- i. *PCR test; OR
 - ii. *complement fixation test; OR
 - iii. *agar gel immune-diffusion test; OR
 - iv. *doxycycline treatment for 30 days prior to shipment; OR
 - v. *chlortetracycline treatment for 30 days prior to shipment; OR
 - vi. *Another test/treatment as permitted by the Government of Bermuda (please specify):

- d) No Newcastle disease has occurred within 50km of the premises during the previous 90 days;
- e) Each bird does not originate from an area under quarantine or travel restriction;
- f) The birds have not been exposed to wild birds during the previous 45 days.
- g) Each animal appears to be fit for the intended travel.

V. This certificate is valid for 10 days.

Notes:

- Birds which are subject to the provisions of the Convention for the International Trade of Endangered Species of Wild Fauna & Flora (CITES) must be the subject of CITES certificates/permits which will accompany the birds on their travel.
- **Importation of animals may be denied on the basis of disease prevalence or outbreak in the region of origin.**
