Extended Knife Surrender Arrangements 2025

Guidance for surrender of ninja swords, knives and other offensive weapons

June 2025



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Summary of the knife surrender arrangements

This guidance sets out clear instructions on how you can safely surrender and dispose of knives and any offensive weapons by using a dedicated surrender bin during the month of July. During this time, a mobile surrender van, operated by FazAmnesty, will operate concurrently with the ninja sword surrender and compensation scheme that will start on 1 July 2025, 00:00hrs and close on 31 July at 23:59hrs. Ninja swords can be disposed of anonymously in a surrender bin or the mobile van, as well as handed in at a police station.

Other knives or offensive weapons that you wish to dispose of can also be securely dropped at a surrender bin or the mobile surrender van. The surrender bins will be retained in specified locations after the surrender scheme has closed at the end of July.

How to surrender

During the one-month (31 days) surrender period, members of the public are encouraged to hand in any knives they no longer wish to keep. If a member of the public has an item considered an offensive weapon, this can also be disposed of in the surrender period.

Items must be wrapped up and placed in a sealed bag or box. **They must not be carried openly at any time.** Carrying bladed articles in public without a good reason or lawful authority is an offence.

You can surrender your weapon(s) one of two ways:

Mobile Surrender Van

A mobile surrender van will be operated by FazAmnesty and will be stationed in **Greater London, West Midlands, and Greater Manchester** at certain dates during the extended surrender period. The mobile surrender van will provide a safe way to dispose of knives and offensive weapons without entering a police station.

What to expect:

- When you arrive, a member of Faz Amnesty staff will guide you through the process.
- You will be asked to safely deposit the item into a secure, surrender bin which is located inside the mobile surrender van.
- **No personal information will be taken, and you will not be asked any questions.**

Surrender Bins

You can also surrender knives or weapons at one of the surrender bins that have been provided. The bins are installed in various safe public locations in **Greater London, West Midlands and Greater Manchester**. They provide a way for you to safely dispose of knives and weapons.

How to use the surrender bin:

- Please check where the nearest surrender bin is to you – this are set out at Annex B.
- The surrender bin will have clear markings on where to deposit knives and other weapons.
- Once deposited, please do not attempt to retrieve the item.
- The bins will be monitored, checked and emptied regularly and knives and weapons will be disposed of securely.

Disposing of knives and weapons safely

You must take all reasonable steps to make any item(s) that you are surrendering safe to handle whilst travelling to the mobile surrender van or a surrender bin. Items must be contained and transported in a manner that does not cause distress or alarm to other members of the public.

Items **must** be wrapped and placed in a sealed bag or box. **They must not be carried openly at any time.** Carrying bladed articles in public without a good reason or lawful authority is an offence. Carrying the items according to these instructions is likely to be considered a 'good reason,' namely that you are about to surrender the articles at your nearest surrender bin or at the mobile surrender van, if stopped by the police.
