Diplomacy

UK, with France, is leading efforts to build a 'Coalition of the Willing' to defend any peace deal and support Ukraine's future security

UK-Ukraine 100 Year Partnership fosters cross-sector collaboration incl. defence & security, science & tech, economy & trade [16 Jan] Supported UNGA resolutions condemning Russia's: invasion [Feb 25, Feb 23, Mar 22]; attempted annexation of 4 Ukrainian regions [Oct 22]; & attacks on Ukraine's energy infrastructure [Jul 24] We use the UNSC to hold Russia to account & reaffirm support for Ukraine. FS used Presidency to mark 1000 days of invasion [18 Nov]

At OSCE, we call out Russia weekly & co-fund Support Programme for Ukraine. <u>4 fact-finding missions</u> reported on human rights abuses. We invoked a <u>5th mission</u> to consider treatment of POWs [24 Jul] At IAEA, we support efforts towards nuclear safety in Ukraine

Military

£10.8bn total & £3bn a year for as long as it takes [10 Jul 24] £2.26bn contribution to G7 ERA Loans, to be repaid with profits from Russian assets. Two thirds now disbursed - 2nd £752m paid [14 Apr] UK therefore expects to provide £4.5bn total support in 2025 [16 Jan] £70m of ERA Loan to fund 350 ASRAAM air defence missiles [25 Jun] £350m for 100,000 drones in 25/26 [4 Jun]. 50k sent in <6mths [21 Jul] >£150m of air defence & artillery delivered in last 2 months [21 Jul] UK & Denmark joint-funding bespoke air defence system [16 Jan] Defence Industrial Support Treaty [Jul 24] expanded export finance cover incl. £2.5bn for Thales to supply 5,000 LMM missiles [10 Jul] UK/Ukraine agreement to share battlefield technology will boost UK drone production for Ukraine [23 Jun]

Op INTERFLEX: >57,000 trained; £247m invested in 2025 [4 Jun] £20m for Project Renovator supports wounded Ukr troops [24 Feb] UK-administered International Fund for Ukraine procures equipment: >£1.8bn pledged to date, incl. £30m Anduril UK drones order [6 Mar]

Non-military

£5.3bn in non-military commitments since Feb 22. This includes:

up to £4.1bn in fiscal support through World Bank loan guarantees
 up to £1.2bn in bilateral assistance. Up to £283m in 25/26 will fund humanitarian, energy, stabilisation, reform, recovery & reconstruction

Humanitarian

>£477m total assistance to Ukraine and the region to end FY 24/25, incl. over £120m in humanitarian assistance in 2024/25 [11 Sep]

Almost £25m new funding to protect the most vulnerable [9 May]

We have committed £12.9 million to HALO Trust for demining, incl. £4.3m for 2025/26. Over 511,000m² land cleared (May 22 to Mar 25)

Recovery & Reconstruction

War risk insurance via MIGA & EBRD boosts inward investment £3.5bn cover limit via UKEF for reconstruction projects supported reconstruction of 6 bridges & delivery of mine countermeasure vessels

Via British International Investment, working with EBRD to offer trade finance to support critical imports/exports. <u>€30m</u> for MHP will protect jobs and boost resilience in food & agriculture sectors [10 Jul]

Up to £10.5m for Governance Reform Programme supports efforts on rule of law, justice and anti-corruption [10 Jul]

£50m economic recovery programme helps SMEs [16 Jan & 5 Feb]

In total, up to £21.8bn committed in support of Ukraine

Energy

Over £400m for energy security and resilience through grant, inkind support and loan guarantees

£84m to UESF incl. £20m for emergency energy needs [17 Dec]
£1m for Ukraine's Green Transition Office in 25/26 [10 Jul]
£181m from UKEF for Urenco to supply enriched uranium to power Ukraine & maintain its independence from Russian fuel [18 Jul 24]
£17m to support UK and Ukrainian innovators through a second round of UK's Innovate Ukraine Green Energy Competition [5 Feb]

Sanctions

>2,500 individuals, entities & ships sanctioned, incl. >2,300 since Putin's full-scale invasion

UK, US and EU sanctions have denied Russia access to at least \$450bn since Feb 2022 - equiv. to ~2 years funding for the invasion

>400 'Shadow Fleet' vessels sanctioned for transporting Russian energy in violation of the Oil Price Cap. By some estimates, Russia spent over \$14bn to establish its 'Shadow Fleet'

Russia pays up to 6 times more for dual-use items & defence sector components have risen 30% over 3 years compared to global prices

This Government has imposed sanctions against:

- <u>135 more oil tankers</u> and 2 entities enabling Russia's illicit shadow fleet oil trade [21 Jul]
- 3 GRU units & 18 officers for malicious cyber activity [18 Jul]
- 100 targets incl. Russia's energy & financial services sectors, military industrial complex & suppliers, and malign actors [20 May]

War Crimes & Justice

£4.5m new funding to support Ukraine's domestic war crimes investigations - total funding now £11.5m [29 Dec]

Additional £2.3m to the International Criminal Court

FS endorsed <u>Special Tribunal for the Crime of Aggression</u> legal basis [9 May] - Ukraine ratified bilateral agreement with CoE [15 Jul]

Register of Damage for Ukrainians to record war-related losses. UK chairs governing body & supports creating Claims Commission - sits on Intergovernmental Negotiation Committee. 3rd meeting 14-18 July

The UK-Ukraine <u>TechBridge</u> delivers projects in mutual trade, investment, innovation research and digital skills development

Our <u>City-Ukraine Hub</u> leverages UK expertise to deliver capacity building projects

Insurance through the UK-developed <u>Unity facility</u> & equipment to deter attacks supported the Black Sea maritime corridor enabling Ukraine to export its goods, incl. all of its 2023 & 2024 harvests

UK-Ukraine Political, Free Trade & Strategic Partnership Agreement enables <u>tariff free trade on all goods</u> until 31 March 2029 (eggs & poultry until 31 March 2026) [8 Feb 24]

Ukrainians in the UK

223,400 Ukrainians have arrived in the UK, including 164,700 via Homes for Ukraine [as of 31 Mar]

<u>Ukraine Permission Extension Scheme</u> opened 4 Feb 2025. 6,637 applications granted [as of 31 Mar]
