NATIONAL HEALTH SERVICE, ENGLAND

The Primary Medical Services (Directed Enhanced Services) (Amendment) Directions 2025

The Secretary of State for Health and Social Care, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 98A(3), 272(7) and (8) and 273(1) of the National Health Service Act 2006(a), gives the following Directions.

Citation, commencement, extent and interpretation.

- 1.—(1) These Directions may be cited as the Primary Medical Services (Directed Enhanced Services) (Amendment) Directions 2025 and come into force on 31 July 2025.
 - (2) These Directions are given to NHS England(b).
 - (3) These Directions extend to England and Wales.
- (4) In these Directions, "the Principal Directions" means the Primary Medical Services (Directed Enhanced Services) Directions 2025.

Amendment to the Principal Directions

- **2.**—(1) The Principal Directions are amended as follows.
- (2) In Direction 4 (Network Contract Directed Enhanced Service Scheme)—
 - (a) in paragraph (1), in sub-paragraph (a) after "Network Contract Directed Enhanced Service Specification" insert—

"published on 27 March 2025 and updated on 31 July 2025".
