## JUDGMENT

1. The complaint of breach of contract in relation to notice pay is well founded. The respondent did not pay part of the claimant's notice period which he worked.
2. The complaint of unauthorised deductions from wages is well founded.
3. The respondent did not pay the claimant wages for the month of March 2024 which included a period of his notice.
4. The respondent shall pay the claimant £2916.67 which is the gross sum unpaid. The claimant is responsible for the payment of any tax and National Insurance on the gross sum received.
