<u>JUDGMENT</u>

- 1. The claim for unauthorised deductions from pay contrary to Part II of the Employment Rights Act 1996 is well-founded. The Respondent made an unauthorised deduction from the Claimant's pay in respect of 2nd July 2024 and 3rd July 2024. The Respondent is ordered to pay the gross sum of £231.54 deducted from the Claimant's pay.
- 2. The claim for financial loss sustained by the Claimant attributable to the unauthorised deduction (based on work-related expenses or losses arising from her employment not being registered with the relevant authorities such as HMRC) is not well-founded. It is therefore dismissed.
