 - I, the undersigned, certify that the birds comprising the flock of origin meet the following requirements:
- a) The farm of origin is free from the following contagious animal diseases:
 - (i) For poultry and turkey holdings ornithosis (psittacosis), paramyxovirus infection, infectious bronchitis, infectious laryngotracheitis, infectious encephalomyelitis, turkey rhinotracheitis - during the last 12 months on the holding;
 - (ii) For goose and duck holdings ornithosis (psittacosis), duck plague, Derzsy's disease, duck virus hepatitis - during the last 12 months on the holding
- b) Only officially approved vaccines have been used in the flock;
- Hatching eggs were disinfected using methods approved in the UK, no later than two hours after laying;
- d) Flocks of origin have not received feed containing raw materials produced using genetic engineering methods or other genetically modified sources;
