- 2. The Respondent failed to pay the Claimant for annual leave accrued but untaken on termination of her employment. The Respondent must pay the Claimant the (gross) sum of £324.09 in respect of the annual leave accrued but untaken.
- The Respondent failed to provide the Claimant with a written statement of employment particulars. The Respondent must pay the Claimant the sum of £462.98 (being two weeks' pay).
