**DECLARATION OF REVOCATION OF SPECIAL MEASURES: AFRICAN SWINE FEVER
IMPORTS OF PORCINE PRODUCTS FROM EEA STATES, THE FAROE ISLANDS, GREENLAND AND SWITZERLAND
THE TRADE IN ANIMALS AND RELATED PRODUCTS (SCOTLAND)
REGULATIONS 2012**

Under regulation 25(3) of the Trade in Animals and Related Products (Scotland) Regulations 2012⁽¹⁾, the Scottish Ministers declare:

Revocation

1. The “Declaration of Special Measures: African Swine Fever. Imports of Ovine and Caprine Products from EEA States, the Faroe Islands, Greenland and Switzerland” made by the Scottish Ministers on 26 September 2024 is revoked.
2. This Declaration has effect from the coming into force of the Animal Products (Control of Personal Importation) (Scotland) Order 2025⁽²⁾.
