## **JUDGMENT**

- 1. The claim was presented in the Bristol Employment Tribunal on 5<sup>th</sup> March 2025 The respondent has failed to present a valid response on time. The Employment Judge has decided that a determination can properly be made of the claim, or part of it, in accordance with rule 22 of the Rules of Procedure.
- 2. The respondent has made unauthorised deductions from the claimant's wages and must pay the claimant £14,512.28 gross.
- 3. The claimant was unfairly dismissed, and the respondent must pay damages to the claimant of £697.70
- 4. The Respondent must pay the Claimant a compensatory award of £3986.83.
- 5. The respondent must pay the claimant £19,196.81 in total.
- 6. The hearing listed on 17th October 2025 is cancelled.
