Question 1

We do not hold information about the circumstances under which completed investigations resulting in prosecutions would not be made publicly available.

Question 2

We interpret "completed and successful cases" as cases where we have made a positive charging decision following an investigation that has proceeded to prosecution. Using this definition, we can confirm that we report on all our prosecutions in the public domain.
