annum. However, the Union has not been able to pay the General Secretary what is owed and has paid the GS only £16350 NET. The liability is calculated based on the pay that is outstanding to the GS plus the total
estimated Tax, National insurance and Employer national insurance that is owed on the full amount. It is
understood that when the debt is paid there will be variance on this estimate.
