

Notification of Registration of Operators, Establishments or Plants Under the Requirements of Article 23 of Assimilated Animal By-Products Regulation (EC) No. 1069/2009

Guidance on completing this form

- you must use this form to register with the Animal and Plant Health Agency (APHA) if you handle or use animal by-products (ABPs) as part of your operations
- full details of who needs to register are in the overview guide for the ABP industry on GOV.UK
- the haulage department of any ABP approved or registered operation does not require separate registration. It is only independent hauliers that need to register. Only one registration form is required for any one haulage company no matter how many depots they may have however, the company should inform APHA of the address of each of their UK depots as part of their registration
- changes to the ownership, address or operation of a registered premises must be notified in writing to APHA and submitted using this form (AB117)

Operators may require registration even if:

 your establishment carries out activities involving ABP for which you already hold approval or registration under assimilated Regulation (EC) No. 852/2004 or Regulation (EC) No. 853/2004 (contact The ABP Team for further information)

The following operations are **not** required to register:

- activities involving the generation of animal by-products on site only, which are carried out on farm or other premises where animals are kept, bred or taken care of
- retail businesses producing a total weight of less than 20kg of raw or partially cooked meat, fish or shellfish
 waste per week which can be sent to landfill (records must be kept of the type and approximate weight of
 ABP sent to landfill each week)
- establishments or plants that require approval under Article 24 of assimilated Regulation (EC) No.
 1069/2009 or any activity associated with that establishment e.g. transport of ABPs. These operations
 including rendering, incineration, combustion, pet food plants, manufacturers of organic fertilisers and soil
 improvers, compost and biogas plants, plants handling and storing animal by-products or products derived
 from animal by-products must apply for approval. Application forms are available on GOV.UK:
