Certificate reference number I, the undersigned official veterinarian, hereby certify that I have verified the information provided to me by the Centre Veterinarian in charge of the semen collection center listed in Box I.11; and that: The semen described in this certificate: II.1. was collected, processed and stored in a semen collection centre, hereinafter "SCC," approved and supervised by the veterinary competent authority of Great Britain or Northern Ireland in accordance with the relevant legislation in force in Great Britain or Northern Ireland. (a) Address of SCC Name of SCC: SCC Centre Approval No Veterinarian was maintained solely under the control of the Centre Veterinarian for the above SCC: initially maintained under the control of the Centre Veterinarian for the above SCC, and subsequently under the control of the Centre Veterinarian for a different semen collection centre, hereinafter "SCC2", currently approved by the veterinary competent authority of Great Britain or Northern Ireland in accordance with the relevant legislation in force in Great Britain or Northern Ireland. This certificate must be issued within 30 days of arrival of the consignment in the United States.

Every straw should be marked and the numerical or alphanumerical sequences should include the SCC approval number, donor breed, individual animal ID and date of semen collection

Box I.25: Approval number of the centre shall correspond to the approval number of the semen centre in which the semen was collected.

Date of collection: shall be indicated in the following format: dd/mm/yyyy.

Donor identity: shall include the official identification mark of the animal and all IDs provided for traceback.

Pig keepers: identify animals before moving them - GOV.UK (www.gov.uk)

Quantity: Number of individual receptacles (ampoules, containers, bags...) used in the shipment for each donor.
