Assurance arrangements

Your Combined Authority must have regard to the English Devolution Accountability Framework¹ and the National Local Growth Assurance Framework², including Adult Education Budget guidelines. The current version of the framework was published in September 2021 by the Department for Levelling Up, Housing and Communities and clarifies what assurances should be in place when administering adult education functions.

In addition, the Department for Education also has an associated Memorandum of Understanding in place with your Combined Authority in relation to the devolution of adult education functions.

Citation

1) This determination may be cited as Devolution of the Adult Education Budget Determination for financial year 2025-26 [31/7825].

Purpose of the grant

 The purpose of the grant is for provision of relevant adult education functions and towards expenditure lawfully incurred or to be incurred through the associated Adult Education Budget.

Determination

3) The Secretary of State determines as the authorities to which grant is to be paid and the amount of grant to be paid, the authorities and the amounts set out in Annex A.
