This letter confirms the amount of delegated Adult Education Budget (AEB) you will receive in the financial year (FY) 2025-26 (1 April 2025 to 31 March 2026) to deliver relevant adult education functions in your delegated area.

Your total delegated AEB for FY2025-26 is set out in the table in Annex A and will be paid by mid-April 2024.
