Documents required for a valid claim of entitlement:

1. Proof of identity – photocard driving licence or passport; and
2. proof of address – two different documents in the applicant's name no older than 3 months, e.g. utility bills; and
3. vehicle registration document, or other proof of ownership for seized property; and
4. valid insurance and driving licence – to be able to lawfully remove the vehicle.
5. If acting as an agent, then also written proof of authority to act as an agent, e.g. valid power of attorney.

Unclaimed property:

In accordance with the Control of Waste (Dealing with Seized Property) (England and Wales) Regulations 2015, *the seizure authority may immediately sell, destroy or otherwise dispose of seized property* in the event of any of the following:

- a) the claim period expires with no claim being made;
- b) the claims made within the claim period are determined to be invalid;
- c) the property is no longer required to be returned.
