Permissions

- 4. Under this licence, subject to the conditions below:
 - 4.1.A UK National may purchase petrol from the <u>a</u> DP at any petrol station in Kyrgyzstan or Tajikistan that is either owned by the DP or sells the <u>a</u> DP's petrol, provided that the petrol is for that UK National's Personal Vehicle;
 - 4.2. A UK National, Relevant UK Institution or the <u>a</u> DP may undertake any activity reasonably necessary to effect the purchase of petrol in accordance with paragraph 4.1.

General

- 5. The permissions in this licence do not authorise any act which will result in a breach of any part of the Russia Regulations, save as permitted under this licence or other licences granted under the Russia Regulations.
- 6. Information provided to HM Treasury in connection with this licence shall be disclosed to third parties only in compliance with the UK General Data Protection Regulation and the Data Protection Act 2018.
- 7. This licence takes effect from 14 March 2025 and expires at 23:59 on 15 March 2027.
- 8. HM Treasury may vary, revoke or suspend this licence at any time.
