REMEDY JUDGMENT

- 1. JUDGMENT on liability was delivered verbally on 9 May 2025. Written reasons were dated 24 July 2025 and sent to the parties on 11 August 2025. Remedy was reserved to be determined separately.
- 2. The unanimous judgment of the Tribunal on remedy in relation to the successful complaint of failure to make reasonable adjustments for disability is that:
 - a. The Claimant is awarded £3,520 for financial loss;
 - b. The Claimant is awarded £18,500 for injury to feelings:
 - c. The Claimant is awarded £0 for personal injury; and
 - d. The Claimant is awarded interest at the rate of 8% in the further sum of £3,392 (£295 for financial loss and £3,097 for injury to feelings).
- 3. The Respondent is therefore ordered to pay the Claimant the total sum of £25,412.
