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IV. Health Information

I, the undersigned, certify that

- (a) No cases of tularaemia in the UK have been confirmed in the previous 2 years.

For each consignment of 4 rabbits or less:

- (b) The rabbit(s) were raised in the UK for more than 90 days prior to export or since birth.
- (c) No cases of rabies, rabbit haemorrhagic disease and myxomatosis have been confirmed in the establishments in the previous year.
- (d) The rabbit(s) were isolated for at least 30 days under veterinary supervision by a UK accredited veterinarian.
- (e) During the quarantine period, the rabbit(s) were examined and found to be in a healthy condition without any clinical signs and subject to the following requirements:
- Broad-spectrum anthelmintics were applied between 5 to 15 days prior to export for internal and external parasites;
 - No signs of infestation of external parasites when inspected.

For each consignment of 5 rabbits or more:

- (f) The Rabbits were raised in the UK for more than 90 days prior to export or after birth.
- (g) The establishments were supervised and recognised by the veterinarians who were responsible for disease diagnosis, notifications and accredited by the competent authority of the UK as follows:
- The sanitary disinfection is regularly conducted, and the records of management of hygiene and feeding are kept.
 - The inspection and maintenance of establishments are regularly conducted and ensured to effectively avoid intrusion of animals from outside.
- (h) No cases of rabies, rabbit haemorrhagic disease and myxomatosis have been confirmed in the establishment in the previous year.
- (i) The rabbit(s) were isolated for at least 30 days under veterinary supervision by a UK accredited veterinarian.
- (j) During the quarantine period, the rabbits were examined and found to be in a healthy condition without any clinical signs and subject to the following requirements:
- Broad-spectrum anthelmintics were applied once between 5 to 15 days prior to export for internal and external parasites;
 - No signs of infestation of external parasites when inspected.

(m) Not more than 24 hours prior to the date of export, I examined the said rabbit(s)* and found it/them* to be free from clinical signs of infectious or contagious disease, including myxomatosis, tularemia, viral haemorrhagic disease and any other infectious and contagious disease to which rabbits are susceptible, and in my opinion, fit to travel.

(n) I have received a declaration from the exporter that the animals shall be transported in cargo holds with clean containers which have been treated with disinfectant approved by the competent authority of the exporting country. No additional feed, straw and forage, bedding or other susceptible animals are allowed to be loaded en route to the destination. The means of transport and transit shall comply with the World Organisation for Animal Health Terrestrial Animal Health Code and the Live Animal Regulations of the International Air Transport Association (IATA).
