I wish to object to this application.

The act of total demolition, quite frankly, doesn't even bear thinking about, albeit a temporary situation. The thought of builders' trucks, pulling up and pulling in, quite possibly trundling down Wesley Place/High Street which are both narrow streets leading into Highland Square and the noise, the dust, the 'comings and goings' is quite dreadful.

Highland Square, Highland Crescent, Worrall Road and Wesley Place suffer constantly with refuse collections, ie. What Rubbish, Biffa, W Smith refuse trucks (amongst others), because of the businesses/pubs in the immediate area and it doesn't bear thinking about increasing accommodation on this site for housing of multiple/student occupation. The new development would generate an increase in online deliveries. The area is already overflowing with cars, vans, motor scooters x 3 and so on.

There are already numerous black bins in Highland Square/Highland Crescent because of the businesses/pubs in the immediate area and fly-tipping is a frequent hazard. Although storage for bins is provided in the application, the reality is actually different.

I haven't all the architectural drawings/heritage statements to hand but it strikes that the 3 x main sections that are already 'in place' would be far better to be converted into residential accommodation and something 'in keeping' with the ambience of this Whiteladies Road conservation area, the windows particularly looked out of keeping.

I would be very grateful if could accept this objection but it remains anonymous.

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
