

MOD DYNAMIC RISK ASSESSMENT FORM

Dynamic Risk Assessment (DRA) complements the specific or generic risk assessment. **Dynamic** risk assessments are used to respond to real time changes in circumstances, increased risk or failure of control measures. A dynamic risk assessment is used for responding to conditions that may be subject to real time changes where further control measures might need to be introduced at short notice to maintain a level of risk that is ALARP and tolerable. Where additional control measures have been implemented, whoever is managing the activity **must** continue to monitor these control measures to make sure that the risk level remains ALARP and tolerable.
