About this privacy notice



This **privacy notice** tells you how we will use and look the information you tell us.



When you fill in the survey, we ask for some **personal information** from you.

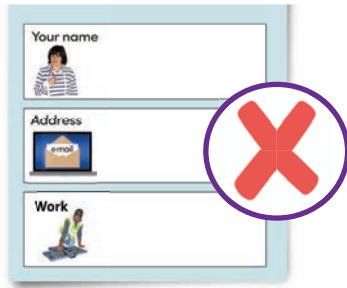
Things like your age, sex and the part of the UK you live in. Or we might ask where you work or who your service works with.



You don't have to give us this information if you don't want to.



We will also see what you tell us in your answers.



But do not tell us any other personal things about yourself in your answers.



We will follow the law about keeping your information safe and private.



We will keep your personal information for 2 years. Then we will delete it.



How to complain

Complain means telling us you are not happy.
