JUDGMENT AT PUBLIC PRELIMINARY HEARING

1. The claimant's harassment related to disability claim is dismissed upon its withdrawal.
2. The claimant's application to amend the claim is refused.
3. The Tribunal does not have jurisdiction to hear the claim because it was presented outside of the primary time limit, there is no possibility of a course of discriminatory conduct, and it is not just and equitable to hear the claim outside of the primary time limit; the claim is dismissed.
4. No complaints brought under this claim number survive this judgment.
