Good Afternoon Jan

Please find attached a draft copy of the updated and varied permit for Nick Brookes.

I have specified the annual tonnage for the three facilities in Tables S2.1 S2.2 and S2.3. As the composting is limited to 500 tonnes per annum I have split the remaining tonnage 50/50 between the waste transfer station and the soil processing facility. If this is not the expected annual throughput for each facility can you please let me know how the remaining 299500 tonnes of waste is expected to be split.

A number of waste streams have been removed from the list of wastes you provided for the waste transfer station, this is due the following reasons:

- The only hazardous wastes the site is permitted to accept under it's permit is Asbestos so all
 other hazardous waste streams have been removed.
- The site is not permitted to accept wastes consisting solely or mainly of dusts, powders or loose fibres and wastes in liquid form.
- All 99 codes have also been removed if a 99 code is to be included within a permit we require
 a full description of the waste stream to be covered by that code. 99 codes should only be
 used if no other EWC code fully describes the waste stream.
- Any waste codes that may be covered by the exemptions that are held by Nick Brookes for this
 site should not be included within the waste streams accepted under the permit. These will be
 regulated by the exemptions.
- Also any waste codes used to cover any waste streams that maybe classed as incidentals are
 also not to be included within the list of wastes permitted to be accepted on site.

If Nick Brookes wish any of the excluded waste streams to be included in the permit please let me know along with justification as to why they are required.

Please note this is working document and maybe subject to further changes. If any further changes are made, yourself and Nick Brookes will be consulted upon the changes. A copy of the draft has also been sent to Rachel Argyros the Environment Officer for the site.

If you can please let me have any comments you or Nick Brookes wish to make on the draft by July 8th.
