\*ii. as far as can be determined, surra (*Trypanosoma evansi*) has not been reported during the 30 days prior to the date of collection and when the disease was reported in the holding during the preceding 2 years prior to collection, the holding remained under movement restrictions following the outbreak and until the date of the last infected animal was removed from the holding and the remaining animals were subjected to a test (as listed in Annex I to EU Regulation 2020/688) for surra with negative results taken at least 6 months after the last infected animal was removed.
