## Proposed Change of Use, Demolition and Development at: 72-74 Gloucester Road, Bishopston, Bristol, BS7 8BF

This letter accompanies a Full Planning application submitted on behalf of Honor Properties Ltd with proposals to convert part of the Gloucester Road building, demolish a rear addition, extend the building and carry out associated alterations. The proposal is to retain a commercial use on the ground floor and at the rear and on the upper floors to create a large apart-hotel providing serviced apartments.
