I wish to object to the above planning application relating to the installation of a multitude of cctv cameras and their supporting structures. I cannot understand why this draconian measure is required to protect what is an essentially "a playing field" which was for the enjoyment the general public a joint usage with a school. The scheme appears to be in excess of that employed at/in the Louvre (Paris). I am under the impression that the site will not house any valuable equipment or buildings.

## My concerns are as follows

- 1. Will the field of view of the cameras be restricted to the school playing areas or cover the whole site (thus infringing on the public's right of privacy).
- 2. Any information obtained through the security installation must be subject to the data protection act.
- 3. Who will be responsible for monitoring / controlling the surveillance devices and will the public have unrestricted access to the recorded data.
- 4. Will all public areas including public right of ways be protected (for the public good).
- 5. Will the restricted public areas be protected against vehicles used in the maintenance of the security system.
- 6. Trees etc, to be protected against any alteration or change to enhance the cctv cameras field of view.
