2. The Claim of accrued and unpaid holiday pay pursuant to regulation 13 of the Working Time Regulations 1998 (As Amended) is well founded and succeeds.
3. The Respondent Company (Company No 15103538) is ordered to pay to the Claimant the total sum of **£2153.85** (net).
