- 2. The Claim of accrued and unpaid holiday pay pursuant to regulation 13 of the Working Time Regulations 1998 (As Amended) is well founded and succeeds.
- 3. The Respondent Company (Company No 15103538) is ordered to pay to the Claimant the total sum of £2153.85 (net).
