I am writing to object to this application to install 24 additional CCTV cameras on Stoke Lodge Sports Ground. These will be 360 degree surveillance cameras.

I live on the opposite side of [REDACTED] ([REDACTED]) I cannot see the justification for such an infringement of privacy. I know of no other Bristol school sports grounds that have, or need, such intensive surveillance.

This would affect all users of the grounds including the children's playground as well as the general public using public roads. Even worse, is the potential for intrusion into local people's privacy inside their own homes and in their gardens.

There can be no justification for this level of intrusion.

This proposal is to install some hideously tall, and ugly, structures in an area surrounding Stoke Lodge which is a Grade II listed building.
