- 1. The claimant was a worker of the respondent at the relevant time within the meaning of section 230 (3)(b) Employment Rights Act 1996. The Tribunal makes a declaration to this effect.
- 2. The complaint of unauthorised deductions from wages is well-founded. The respondent made unlawful deductions from the claimant's pay in January (£306) and February 2025 (£50). The respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the gross sum of £356.00.
