Introduction

1. The Iraq (Sanctions) (EU Exit) Regulations 2020 (S.I. 2020/707) were made under the Sanctions and Anti-Money Laundering Act 2018 (the Sanctions Act) and provide for imposition of financial sanctions, including the freezing of funds and economic resources of persons involved in the former Government of Iraq and its state bodies, corporations or agencies.
2. On 10 December 2025 the Foreign, Commonwealth and Development Office updated the UK Sanctions List on GOV.UK. This list provides details of those designated under regulations made under the Sanctions Act. A link to the UK Sanctions List can be found below.
3. Following the publication of the UK Sanctions List, information on the Consolidated List has been updated.

5. Information received by OFSI may be disclosed to third parties in accordance with provisions set out in the Information and Records part of the regulations and in compliance with applicable data protection laws.
6. Failure to comply with UK financial sanctions legislation or to seek to circumvent its provisions may be a criminal offence.
