S62A/2025/0133 - Stoke Lodge Playing Fields, West Dene, Shirehampton, Bristol BS9 2BH

I wish to object to the above planning application to install 8 CCTV cameras and poles on Stoke Lodge Playing Fields for the following reasons:

1. The visual impact on the landscape and the listed building would be huge and would completely change its tranquil and peaceful environment.
2. As a user of the Public Rights of Ways across Stoke Lodge Playing fields, knowing that all movements would be recorded and stored creates a sense of intrusion.
3. Some of the cameras would be situated adjacent to neighbouring properties and the loss of privacy and potential/perceived surveillance for local residents is unacceptable.
4. The installation of 8 CCTV cameras on the land for crime prevention/safeguarding reasons is totally disproportionate. BS9 has a low crime rate and the CCTV cameras would create a perceived level of threat that doesn't exist.
5. The potential damage to trees to install the CCTV cameras is also unacceptable.
