I thoroughly approve of the proposed statutory monitoring and fuel finder feedback to consumers.

I noticed while I was in France a few years ago that the French Government was involved giving information on road fuel, and that finding price information on every fuel station was easy. It was also giving overall information on fuel and oil prices. Possibly as a result of this freedom of information the fuel prices in France were adjusted down after a peak oil price, months ahead of prices coming down in the UK. That smacks of profiteering at the expense of the UK consumer. Fuel companies are multinationals and play markets especially where there are weaknesses.

At the moment all the information I can find on fuel comes from APPS that rely on user information, which is very patchy and sometimes inaccurate.
