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## **1. Welcome and Introductions**

The Chair welcomed members to the meeting and introduced Julien Dehornoy, Network Rail's new Deputy Regional Managing Director.

## **2. Review of Minutes and Actions**

## **3. Government Update**

JA stated that DfT is pleased with progress of Spatial Scope Plan Option 12B, and that there has been very good engagement and collaboration from Partners. DfT looking forward to receiving final report and supporting papers to take into Government governance with the aim of then allowing the restart of design work. She was pleased to note that the Community Hub had now opened to the public. Finally, she noted that the Government intended to publish its 10-year infrastructure strategy shortly after the Spending Review announcement.

AO noted that the DfT was working with HS2 on its project reset and was awaiting revised cost and schedule detail.

## **4. Vision for Euston**

[REDACTED] presented the slides to Partners.

A version 3 of the vision and supporting objectives was shared. This had been informed by extensive partner and community feedback as well as feedback from the Rail Minister. The latest version attempted to better capture Euston's unique selling point – a combination of transport connectivity, knowledge economy and well-established local communities. Each of the three objectives has also been 'flipped' to ensure a people-first focus.

Partners offered some detailed thoughts on the drafting. There was general support for the vision and objectives and a desire to start using them publicly.

Action JUN4.01 – BW to develop [REDACTED] based on the Board's feedback.

## 5. Spatial Scope Plan and communications plan

JR reported that letters of support had now been received from all parties and that Spatial Scope Plan Option 12b was supported by all partners as the basis to proceed to the next phase (design restart and master planning). This represented an enormous task and a significant achievement. He thanked all partners, highlighting those who had worked hard behind the scenes to get letters of support.

JA explained that the Rail Minister would now be briefed before the spatial scope plan and material from the supporting workstreams would be taken forward to wider Government governance. That process will take some time but it is clear that we are on the cusp of a way forward.

EH asked that the partner letters of support be shared. All partners confirmed that they were content for their letters to be shared with all other partners.

Action JUN5.01 - JR to circulate all letters to all partners.

Board members shared their support for the approach taken and recognised the progress that the spatial scope work represented. There was also recognition that there was much work to still do and that effective collaboration needed to continue.

### Communications plan

BW presented a draft communications plan. He recognised that the progress made on the programme was worthy of celebrating and proposed a two-phase approach.

Phase 1 would be before Government endorsement of the spatial plan and approval to continue to the next stage of design restart. [REDACTED]
