Dear Inspectorate,

I wish to register objections to the proposed installation of CCTV poles and cameras 5 and 8.

Objection A:

I live on [REDACTED] and my front garden, front door, lounge bay window, and bedroom bay window will fall within the yellow radius of camera [REDACTED], designated as an "area where persons can be detected and observed" on p11 as of the specification document: (Cotham_School_Playing_Fields_CCTV_System_Specification__Technical_Design-v1.8_06.10.2025_Redacted.pdf).

This is an unacceptable invasion of my right to privacy and I do not accept that subsequent software processing of any recorded images by a trained operator protects that right to privacy.

Objection B:

There is also a public children's playground within the yellow radius of camera 8 that is not clearly identified on the proposal documents but is designated in the specification document as an "area where persons can be detected and observed". CCTV coverage of this area by a third party is inappropriate.

Objection C:

Stoke Lodge is a polling station and the proposed geographical siting of camera 5 would allow CCTV observation of voter activity, and that should not be possible.
