I wish to object to the proposals to site extensive CCTV surveillance on public open space with public rights of way going through it. I am a local resident, considerably more local than the school making these proposals on land they do not own. I can see the trees that should be protected by Tree Preservation Orders by the Local Authority from my bedroom window. This is my nearest open, green space and I have taken annual photos of my grandchildren next to the carved Cedar tree since 2016, walking across the field from Grandad's house, when we can. The proposals for the CCTV surveillance are disproportionate in the extreme, and if installed would be intimidating and obtrusive in a public open space with public rights of way. I also commend to you the submission by the Bristol Tree Forum which I find very sensible.
