The application appears to take no account of the established Rights of Way crossing the site.

The appearance of the 8 huge CCTV towers with powerful lighting would seem more in place in a Prison environment than a wonderful historic Parkland setting which is much loved not only by the local community but also by the many sports clubs that have safely used the site entirely unfenced & unobserved by CCTV, for many decades.
