I live locally and wish to object to the above application for eight six-metre high CCTV towers (each with three cameras) around Stoke Lodge.

I have lived at this address for [REDACTED] and have always used Stoke Lodge open parkland space for exercise, meeting friends and neighbours, and my well being. I have always felt safe in this neighbourhood and have never experienced criminality, particularly in and around Stoke Lodge.

If the application were to go ahead, it would have a massively negative impact on our local community, our privacy invaded (especially for those living around the perimeter of Stoke Lodge) by unnecessary and excessive means.

The impact to the environment would be affected, this was once within the curtilage of Stoke Lodge historic building and land which is designated as "An Important Open Space" (Policy BCS9 and DM27)

The work to install the CCTV towers would have a negative affect on the ecosystems, wildlife and TPOs by the concrete work that would be required at the base of each pole

There are Public Rights Of Ways in existence and the poles would interfere with agreed routes and infringe the privacy to the general public using these routes

In addition, I feel this application will increase the divide between the local community and Cotham School further.

For these reasons I would like to strongly object to this planning application and thank you for taking the time to understand my concerns.
