Dear Planning Inspector,

I am writing as someone who uses Stoke Lodge almost every day with my family. We walk our dog here, my children play football and cricket on the grass, and we often stop at the play park. It is a peaceful, welcoming space that feels part of our community.

The proposal to install eight CCTV cameras on six-metre poles would completely change that atmosphere. The poles would be visually harsh and out of place in this historic parkland. Camera 4, near the "Tree of Life" sculpture, and Camera 5, on a public right of way, would be especially damaging.

This is not a high-crime area, and the school already has cameras covering the parts it uses. Continuous surveillance of the whole field is unnecessary, intrusive, and unsettling for local residents.

I therefore urge the Planning Inspectorate to refuse application S62A/2025/0133.
