(Gloucester Rd is a mainly independent shopping street .The longest in the country With residential houses mainly built in the Victorian era radiating from it .

The three streets will be affected are ours Shadwell and also Wolesley and Raglan.These streets are popular with young families for the good schools nearby and with older people for the closeness of the shops)

Parking will become increasingly difficult It is already a major problem for residents shopkeepers builders and removal vehicles sometimes these have damaged resident's vehicles.

Consequently people park partly on pavement(Which affects people with prams the elderly and disabled forcing them to walk in the road Some people also end up parking on the double yellows which are right in front of the proposed development .

The junction at the bottom of the road is a dangerous one.

Noise could also be a problem particularly for those adjoining properties and those with young children.

I would not object to this property to be converted into 2 residential properties as this would not have such an impact and surely this is what is needed .
