## JUDGMENT

The Judgment of the Tribunal is as follows:

1. Taking account of the primary time limit and the relevant provisions as to early conciliation, the claims by all Claimants against the Second Respondent are out of time.

2. It was reasonably practicable for the claims against the Second Respondent to be brought in time.
3. The claims against the Second Respondent are therefore dismissed.
4. The claims of each Claimant against the First Respondent being conditional on the Second Respondent being a party to the proceedings, and in the light of paragraph 3 of this judgment, the claims against the First Respondent are struck out as having no reasonable prospect of success within the meaning of rule 38(1)(a) of the Employment Tribunal Procedure Rules 2024.
