Documents required for a valid claim of entitlement:

1. Proof of identity – photocard driving licence or passport; and
2. proof of address – two different documents in the applicant's name no older than 3 months, e.g. utility bills; and
3. vehicle registration document, or other proof of ownership for seized property; and
4. valid insurance and driving licence – to be able to lawfully remove the vehicle.
5. If acting as an agent, then also written proof of authority to act as an agent, e.g. valid power of attorney.

Unclaimed property:

In accordance with the Control of Waste (Dealing with Seized Property) (England and Wales) Regulations 2015, the seizure authority may immediately sell, destroy or otherwise dispose of seized property in the event of any of the following:

- a) the claim period expires with no claim being made;
- b) the claims made within the claim period are determined to be invalid;
- c) the property is no longer required to be returned.
