The table below presents a list of chemicals that the Office for Product Safety and Standards (OPSS) has prioritised for assessment by the SAG-CS regarding their safety in consumer products between January and December 2026.

Note:

- The chemicals are not listed in an order in which they will be assessed by the SAG-CS.
- This workplan may change depending on the receipt of safety data in response to various calls for data issued by OPSS, additional data requests from stakeholders, (including novel substances), receipt of derogation applications from industry for carcinogenic, mutagenic or reprotoxic (CMR) substances and change in priorities by OPSS.
